ASSUMING TOO MUCH? — Considering the Realities

We live in a multi-racial, multi-religious society that should cause us to consider the assumptions we make in evangelism. It will become clear in this first session that we run a real risk of miscommunication if we assume too much. So just where does one begin when communicating the Gospel to those who know little or nothing about the Bible?

TRUSTING A STRANGER? — Examining our Expectations

We are increasingly suspicious and distrusting of others. But the Bible's message is all about trust — trusting in the Person and work of Jesus Christ. Is it reasonable, then, to expect our friends to trust God if they do not understand who he is or what he is like? Are we expecting people to trust a stranger?





UNSURE ABOUT THE MESSAGE? — Identifying the Essentials

In a biblically illiterate society, there are definite advantages to taking the appropriate amount of time to provide the necessary background. After all, the Bible is a big book. Watch, listen and participate as a home-based teaching method is modeled, one that lets the message speak for itself.

ABBREVIATING THE GOSPEL? — Assessing our Strategy

It is no secret that much evangelistic effort today tends to misfire. This is partly because it fails to help the unsaved comprehend their problem — their lost condition. We can be guilty of offering a solution to a problem people don't know they have. You will learn an effective biblical strategy for avoiding this problem.

ARE WE COMMUNICATING? — Connecting the Dots

A clearly understood Gospel is a powerful Gospel. It saves! When the significance of Old Testament stories are connected to the Person and work of Jesus Christ, it becomes like the final pieces of a puzzle — it makes profound sense! Don't be surprised if your student rightly concludes, *"This just has to be true!"*

WHAT'S THE NEXT STEP? — Evaluating the Response

The Gospel demands a response. The question addressed is the same asked by the Philippian jailer, *"What must I do to be saved?"* Paul and Silas clearly instructed him to place his faith in the right object — *"Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ..."* It is an accurate understanding of the Gospel that makes all the difference when people come to the point of placing their faith in him.





WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE? — A Call to Action

As Christ's ambassadors, we have been commissioned to make it our lifestyle to engage in sharing the life-saving message of the Gospel — to enable people to rethink their worldview in light of the truth of God's Word.
